Re. Behaviour Expectations of Students in College

At All Saints Catholic College we are committed to ensuring the best education for students. Effective relationships with parents are key to ensuring we work together to ensure the best education for your child.

From the week commencing Monday 10th February we are going to have a focus on basic standards and expectations in line with the Behaviour for Learning (BfL) policy. We want to ensure students are in school on time, ready to learn, engaging with their learning and making positive choices. This focus on standards is to help ensure students are focused on their studies, making good progress and demonstrating their potential.

We want to work with you as partners to ensure a good education for all. We hope that you will support us in upholding these basic standards. This will involve you speaking to your child when they have not met the required expectations, attending meetings and supporting us in upholding school policy. Our College motto is 'Love, Serve, Learn', and living by this ethos we want to help young people to realise their potential and realise their aspirations. We hope that you will support us in re-focusing our standards and work with us to uphold these basic expectations.

This letter outlines our expectations for students under the following headings:

Following instructions –

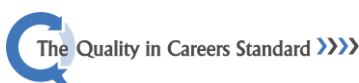
It is important that we work together to ensure that students follow expectations and rules of the College. We want to help students to make positive choices and take responsibility for their behaviour. Our expectation is that students follow instructions given by all staff, first time every time. Students will be given take up time, following this failure to comply may lead to inclusion or exclusion.

Punctuality –

Students should be in school and ready to learn from 8.50am. This is to ensure that students are in Period 1 for the start of lesson, ready to learn. Students arriving at any time after this will be issued a C3 detention. Students who are late to other lessons throughout the day will also be issued a C3 detention. We want to ensure minimal learning time is lost through student lateness.

Uniform –

We have high standards of presentation at the College, and it is important that students are in full uniform at all times. Full details of the school uniform can be found in the BfL policy, in the

Student Planner and on our website. Failure to comply will result in C3 detention. Defiance in relation to uniform or persistent breaches of standards can lead to inclusion or exclusion.

Mobile Phones -

Students are not to use their phones in the College, as these can be a distraction from learning. The BfL policy outlines the school rules in relation to their use - "Mobile/Smart phones must be switched off at all times during the College day, including break and lunchtimes, and remain off whilst students are in College".

If this rule is breached, the phone will be confiscated.

For the first offence the student can collect their phone from Student Services at the end of the school day. Any instances following this will result in the phone needing to be collected by the parent. If a student refuses to hand over their phone, we will endeavour to make contact with you so we can get your support. Further refusal will be treated as defiance which can lead to inclusion or exclusion.

Detentions -

If students are not making good choices, they may be issued detentions. We hope that you will support us in ensuring that students are attending their detentions and clearing these. This is important as it helps to resolve instances of behaviour so we can move forward. If a student receives more than 4 hours detention in a week and has made no attempt to attend them, inclusion will be issued.

We will be speaking to students and working with them through assemblies, form time and lessons to stress the importance of these expectations. Set out below is what we expect from students in the classroom and around the College.

Student standards for lessons -

To ensure all students are here, ready to learn, we expect the following:

- Be punctual to lessons and assemblies
- Planner on desk
- Mobile phones and personal technology switched off and not visible
- Wear correct uniform, in the correct way at all times
- Have equipment and be ready to learn.
- Aim for high standards, complete work to the best of your ability.
- Follow instructions by all staff, first time, every time.

Student standards for lessons outside of the classroom -

To ensure the College is calm and purposeful we expect the following:

- Respect the school environment
- Walk on the left on corridors and stairs
- Put litter in bins
- Eat food in designated areas only, at breaks and lunches
